Dr. Sara Larios Mitchell was inducted to our club on Friday. Dr. Mitchell is the CEO of Star Vista (formerly YFES or Youth and Family Enrichment Services), she is a San Francisco native and a long-time Peninsula resident. She has a Ph.D. and a Master's degree in Counseling Psychology which makes her way over educated for our club, but hopefully she won't catch on. Dr. Mitchell recalled how much she enjoyed speaking to our club in her role as CEO of Star Vista and looks forward to being a member.
